## Maintenance tips

Regular cleaning and preventative maintenance will keep the carpet looking good for as long as possible, it helps to keep up with general carpet cleaning as best and often as you can.

Stains, dirt, fading and flattening can all affect a carpet's appearance. With regular cleaning, the carpet will retain that showroom appearance for longer.

- Use doormats at entrances and exits to take the brunt of outside dirt before it can be walked into the carpet
- It's preferable to use an upright vacuum cleaner with a beater bar to lift and loosen dirt. Vacuum regularly and thoroughly to stop general build-up.
- Move your furniture every few weeks – not only will it stop heavy furniture from denting the carpet, but it will also allow you to get to previously hidden areas of dirt.
- Attend to stains and spills immediately.

### Stains – top tips for removal

- Act quickly – absorb the spill by blotting it using a clean sponge, or kitchen towel,
- Don't use too much water – using too much water can damage your carpet – or if the water is too hot – and can even make the stain worse.
- Dab, don't rub – sometimes scrubbing at stains can damage the carpet and will push the stain into the fibres. Work from the outside in, and dab.
- Make sure you treat your carpet with care when cleaning it, too. Cleaning too frequently can speed up the natural wear of a carpet.

## Carpet Wear

With a regular cleaning regime, the pile of your carpet should not wear down to the backing as a result of normal domestic use. However, flattening, matting, fading or damage due to abuse or poor maintenance cannot be viewed as a manufacturing fault.
